#### BOLOGNA

*Biblioteca Comunale annessa al Conservatorio di Musica G.B. Martini* (for merly called *Biblioteca del Liceo Musicale*) (1955).

The library has a printed catalogue (G. Gaspari, *Catalogo della Biblioteca del Liceo Musicale di Bologna*, 4 vols., Bologna, 1890-1905). This cata-

logue is arranged by subjects. It lists, in the section on musical treatises, along with the printed books of the library, its collection of mss. con-

taining such treatises (vol. I, p. 157-268; 347-356). Gaspari lists all theoretical mss. of the library. He follows an alphabetical order, by authors, and does not always indicate the age of the mss. He does not regularly indicate the pages or folios on which a treatise is found, and he gives no shelf marks (they are entered in ink in the library copy). Hence it is not always clear from Gaspari whether several works are found in the same manuscript, and in which order. The following list is based on the library copy of Gaspari:

It does not usually indicate the age of the mss., but there is a list of earlier mss. (including the sixteenth century) at the end of the second volume.

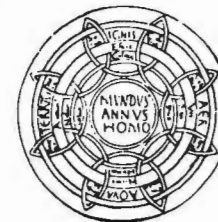
